During the pandemic, I had to take a break from being a Courier. With my mom, I have been taking care of my grandfather, who's 96 and has Dementia, so I had to be extra safe. I enjoyed playing cards, doing puzzles, watching movies and walking with him. I cooked a lot during the pandemic with my mom. I also really looked forward to the regular Good Foot social Zoom calls.

Now that it's safe, I'm excited to get back to work as a Courier. **It means a lot to me to be able to earn my own money and be more independent.** Working at Good Foot has helped me earn money so I can make my own decisions about where to shop and what things to buy. It's nice having all my Good Foot friends share stories about what they like to do and how they spend their time. It helps give me a bit of a different perspective. I've also been helping out with some of Good Foot's new video shoots, which have been a lot of fun.

Autism is interesting because there is such a spectrum! **People have so many** different abilities and talents, and it's nice to work at Good Foot where they know that. It makes for a nice work environment.
